

I know many of you have asked and are curious about the safety protocol that the elders are planning on implementing next Sunday (5/31) as we gather back inside the building. **Please read through these very carefully.** Also remember to pray for and be patient with our elders as they make these difficult decisions...

1. **First**, we will use only two entrances: The double doors on both sides of the building. Stand outside as a family separated from other families by 6ft or more and please wear a mask. If you do not have a mask, we can provide one. Entrance will be done in an orderly manner in order to maintain social distancing as much as possible.
2. **Before you enter**, your temperature will be checked. If you are not feeling well for any reason, or have been in close contact with someone who has been sick, please remain at home.
3. **As you enter the building**, stop at the first table immediately inside the double doors where each family member can use hand sanitizer.
4. **Next**, proceed to the main auditorium entrance. Here, at another table, you will meet Charles Nelson and Tab Vines (both wearing PPE). You will pick up your Lord's Supper emblems (as needed - if you want to bring your own, please do) and also be able to leave your contribution. Please observe social distancing by family groups while you are waiting in line.
5. **You will then be escorted** by family to a specific location for seating, where each family will be properly distanced from other families. Families will need to remain together in this location to provide for an orderly departure. Please do not allow your children to run around after services. (Also Note: Please wear your masks for the entirety of the time you are inside the building.)
6. **For Bathrooms:** We will have two people standing outside the bathrooms to keep track of how many people are inside. Please see one of them before entering.
7. **As difficult as it will be, please avoid shaking hands and hugging.**
8. **Again**, if you are not feeling well (please check your own temperature before arriving at the building), have been around someone who is sick, or are still uncomfortable being out in public, please feel free to join us via the Livestream.

For this first week back (on the 31st), we will only meet at 10 am for worship services. David and Jerry will continue utilizing the website, Facebook, and Youtube for our Sunday and Wednesday Bible classes (at 3 pm Sunday afternoon and 7 pm Wednesday evening). Our Sunday evening worship and our Bible classes will be phased back in at a later date.
